Each year, we invite teachers and students to experience live ballet by attending a Royal New Zealand Ballet performance, where they can delight in one of our main stage productions or one of our specially tailored school matinees.

Attending a Ballet With Your School Group

In addition to matinees just for schools in selected venues, the RNZB offers discounted tickets for school groups to selected performances, for each of our productions to encourage you and your students to experience the thrill of live dance.

Discounted tickets for school groups are available for the following centres: Auckland, Christchurch, Dunedin, Invercargill, Napier, Palmerston North, Rotorua and Wellington.

Ticket Prices

\$15 School Children/Teachers (ratio 9:1)

For school matinee performances: \$20 per additional adult ticket, up to a maximum of 5. For public performances: Additional adult tickets will be charged at the full ticket price for the reserve booked.

You will need 1 teacher for every 9 students, with a maximum of an additional 5 parents or teachers. Groups must be a minimum of 10 people.

Invoicing, Final Numbers & Payment

Once your reservation has been processed, we will send you an initial email confirmation. Please carefully review the confirmation for show title, date, time, and number of tickets in your reservation.

For our school matinees; our team will be in touch with a reminder to confirm your numbers, and 12 weeks prior to the performance an invoice for the full amount will be sent.

Your final ticket count for the reservation is due at least 12 weeks prior to your scheduled performance. Inside 12 weeks, changes to ticket numbers and order balances due will not be possible.

Cancellations

For School Matinee performances, once a booking has been invoiced and finalised at 12 weeks prior to the performance, cancellations or changes cannot be made.

For School Group bookings made for public performances, the balance will be charged 4 weeks our from the performance, per our standard group booking policy. Tickets are non-refundable and non-transferrable.

In the event the RNZB must cancel a performance for any reason, your school will be eligible for a full refund, transfer to a new date (if the performance is rescheduled) or for the full balance to be kept as a credit on account.
